Criteria and Application 2010

What is the SAA scholarship?

The Schaumburg Athletic Association Executive Board is offering a \$1,000.00 scholarship.

Who can apply for the SAA Scholarship?

This scholarship is open to any District 211 high school senior meeting the criteria below. The Scholarship will be awarded to the one candidate who gets the highest score on the selection ranking.

Scholarship Criteria

Each applicant must meet the following requirements in order to be considered for the SAA scholarship:

- Five (5) years total participation as a team player within the SAA organization prior to Senior year. Total participation can be in one sport or a combination of sports. If you have participated in SAA in other activities, please be sure to include that; however, this does not satisfy the 5 year requirement.
- A minimum GPA of 2.5 (unweighted).

What documentation is required?

Each applicant must submit the following by **March 31, 2010**:

- A **completed application** (in this brochure or from the SAA web site)
- **Official GPA Records** verifying that you meet the GPA requirement for the scholarship.
- A **letter of recommendation** from a high school counselor, teacher, principal, etc. This letter should answer the question, "How does this person exemplify the attributes described in the SAA Mission?"
- A **letter of recommendation** from a coach or manager in one of the sports in which you participated. This letter should also answer the question, "How does this person exemplify the attributes described in the SAA Mission?"
- An **essay** stating how you feel you represent the SAA Mission, what your plans are for the scholarship, and your views and opinions of SAA and how your experiences in the organization have helped you/will help you reach your goals.



When will the scholarship be awarded?

A committee from Schaumburg Athletic Association will review all applications. The scholarship winner will be notified after **May 17, 2010** and will receive their scholarship at the **June 21, 2010** Executive Board meeting.
